

Job Description: Lifesaving Society Trainer

Purpose

Trainers are responsible for preparing candidates to assume leadership roles as Lifesaving Society Instructors, Examiners, and Coaches.

Certification

Certified by the Lifesaving Society for a two-year term; may re-certify for additional two-year terms through the Society's recertification process.

Reporting Relationship

To the Lifesaving Society.

Responsibilities

Lifesaving Society Trainers:

1. Teach, evaluate, and certify candidates for Lifesaving Society Instructor, Examiner and Coach certifications:
 - o in the topical streams in which they are appropriately qualified, and
 - o in accordance with the policies, procedures and standards of the Society and the Leadership Code of Conduct.
2. Assure the quality and integrity of the Society's leadership training programs through current professional knowledge and expertise in learning, teaching, evaluation, and mentoring.
3. Act as expert resources in matters related to learning, teaching, evaluating, and mentoring within the Society's leadership training system.
4. Deliver Lifesaving Society leadership courses on an ongoing basis and leadership update clinics as required.
5. Complete all administrative requirements in a timely manner.
6. Provide apprenticeship, professional development opportunities, and guidance for Trainer candidates as assigned.
7. Assist in the identification, recruitment and development of potential Trainers.
8. Attend Trainer workshops and clinics as required.
