Spring Thaw & Rotting Ice

It is easy to get carried away in Spring! Spring thaw is dangerous because the melting snow and rain makes river water rise and run fast. It is easy to slip on a muddy river bank and fall into cold water.

Did you know that ice rots this time of year? Recognize the hazards by looking for ice that has water on it, slush, cracks/holes or is grey with dirty veins. Once ice starts to rot the thickness cannot be used to determine if it is safe, even if it looks solid.
