Subject: Addendum to Policies and Procedures – Aquatic Emergency Care

Alberta and Northwest Territories Policies and Procedures Addendums are designed to provide Affiliate Delivery Partners, Leadership Volunteers, and Members with topic specific clarification, updates, and changes to the Lifesaving Society Alberta and Northwest Territories Branch Policies and Procedures. The clarification and/or changes in this bulletin take effect from the date of publication of this addendum.

- Aquatic Emergency Care (Original and Recertification) is no longer a workplace approved first aid program.
- Aquatic Emergency Care no longer includes CPR, AED, Emergency First Aid, and Standard First Aid.
- The pre-requisite for Aquatic Emergency Care is a current Alberta Government Workplace Approved Standard First Aid.
- Aquatic Emergency Care is a 4-hour module.
- Aquatic Emergency Care Recertification is retired.
