The Lifesaving Society is pleased to offer the Lifesaving Sport Scholarship Program for athletes and officials who are representing Canada at the World Life Saving Championships in Gold Coast, Australia. The Society will award scholarships based on athletes being appointed to Canada's National or Development Teams and for Officials who have had their appointments endorsed by the Branch.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must be a resident of Alberta or the Northwest Territories, a member in good standing and a registered athlete or current official. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to the humanitarian mandate of the Society by giving back (see volunteer opportunities) and/or a demonstrated financial need. Preference will be given to those who meet all criteria.

Only the following international championships will be considered eligible; World Games, Rescue Series: World Lifesaving Championships, RLSS Commonwealth Festival of Lifesaving.

APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants must submit this application with complete contact information, championships information, including athlete contribution, demonstrated financial need, and volunteer opportunities identified to give back to the Society mandate. Successful applicants will receive written confirmation of the scholarship awarded.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship is to be used by the recipient to supplement the athlete / official's contribution for the championships. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the recipient to a maximum of \$400 of the athlete contribution. Recipients that do not participate in the event will be required to return the full scholarship to the Society.
