year while boating.

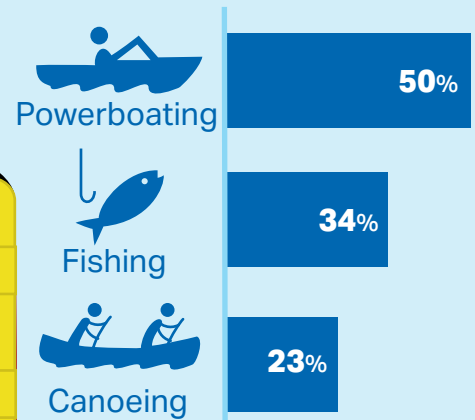
Drowning statistics consistently show that

Transport Canada is seeking public feedback on legislation that would save lives by requiring recreational boaters to wear a lifejacket/PFD.

Wearing a lifejacket or PFD is the most effective way to reduce boating-related drownings in Canada.
