year while boating.

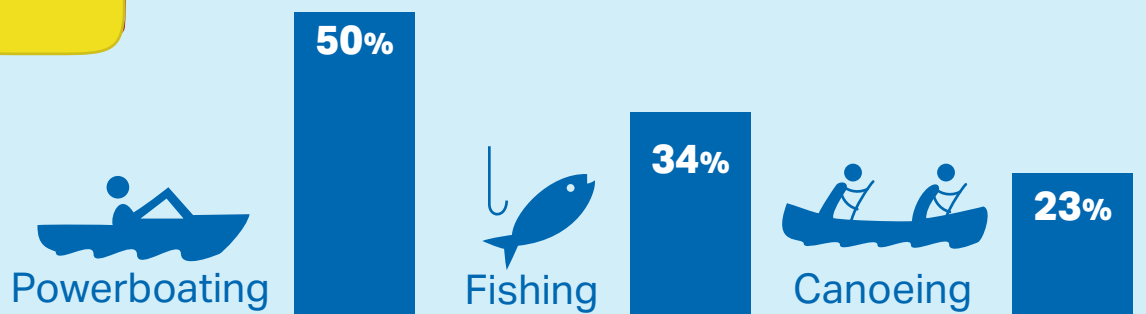
Drowning statistics
