| Purpose | The purpose of this Safety Plan is to identify lines of responsibility and authority should an incident (major or minor) occur during the Camrose Mix Master meet being hosted by the Mayer Aquatic Centre. |

| Operational Procedures | Operational procedures require the facility to meet the minimum Alberta Legislation and Regulations. Lifesaving sport competition may require temporary alterations to these, for example, circulation may need to be turned down/off to minimize the movement of the manikins once they are placed. |
| Emergency Procedures | The Safety Officer is representing the safe operations of the swim meet and is a liaison between the Mayer Aquatic Centre staff (lifeguards) and Key Officials. Emergency Procedures are outlined by the City of Camrose and will be led by City staff (lifeguards) and followed by all attendees. |
| Code of Conduct | Oaths of conduct will be expressed at the start of the swim meet. It is expected that all Spectators, Athletes, Officials and Coaches will conduct themselves as expected and outlined in the AB NWT competition manual. |
| Contingency Plans | Any disruption in the outlined schedule will result in a contingency plan being outlined at the time of the event. It may include a reduction in events available. |
| General Safety | All attendees will adhere to the Alberta Legislation and Regulations as well as facility specific rules that will be followed for patron safety. Lifesaving Society Certified National Lifeguards will be supplied by the facility for the duration of the event. All general rules and procedures pertaining to competitions can be found in the most recent AB/NWT Competition manual and any supporting documents. |
| Major-Minor Incidents | Should an incident (minor) occur, the Safety Officer will be notified and first aid (if needed) will be administered by the attending Mayer Aquatic staff (lifeguards). Documentation will be completed as per swim meet requirements and in accordance with the policies and procedures of the Mayer Aquatic Centre. |

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| | <p>Should an incident (major) occur, Mayer Aquatic Centre staff – Lifeguards will be notified immediately along with the Safety Officer. The Mayer Aquatic Centre staff will manage the incident in accordance with the City of Camrose policies and procedures. All attending athletes, spectators, coaches and officials will listen to direction from the staff and will follow what is required of them. Documentation will be completed as per swim meet requirements and in accordance with the policies and procedures of the Mayer Aquatic Centre.</p> |
