**Warm-up Information:**

Warm-ups will be in 2 x 30 min sessions, last 10 minutes of each session for one way diving, lanes 8 & 9 will be open for diving for the full 60 minutes session. Warmup lanes will be assigned and communicated to coaches after the entry deadline

Meet management reserves the right to modify the warmup schedule as needed based on registration numbers. Any changes will be communicated to all head coaches.

**Seeding:**

Competitors shall be seeded for each event based on entry times submitted with registration.
